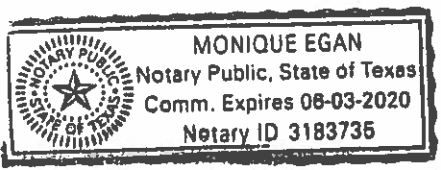

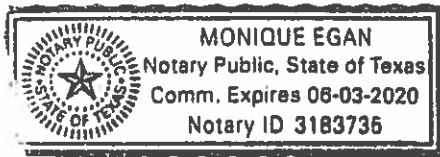

LaMarcus Aldridge anotó 22 puntos, Bryn Forbes añadió 20 y los Spurs remontaron para vencer 120-111 a los Knicks de Nueva York en el AT&T Center de San Antonio, en un auspicioso debut en la nueva temporada de la NBA.
