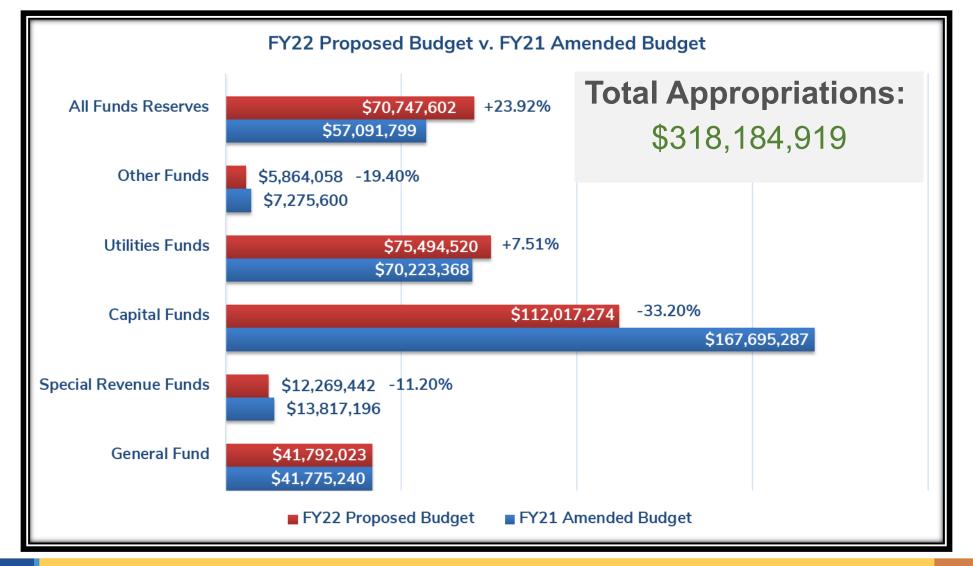

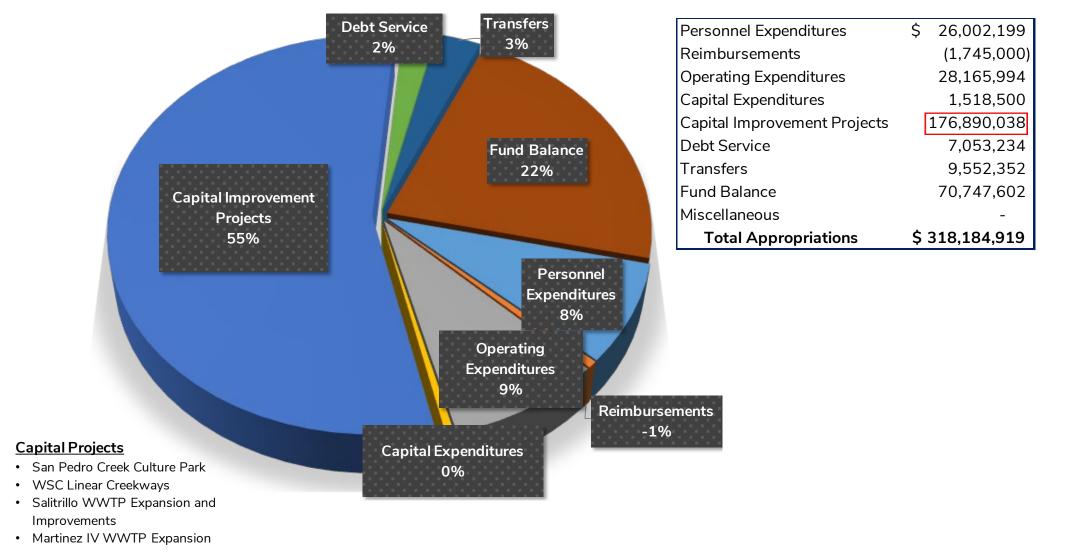

## FY22 Budget Development: Property Tax

- Considerations:
  - Volatility in property valuations across district
  - Volatility in project cost and commodities
  - Anticipated Level of Service / Other Key Initiatives
  - Renewal and Replacement Fund







### Budget Development: New Resources

Category	FY21 Adopted Budget	FY22 Adopted Budget
Personnel Resources	953,948	671,375
Operations Resources	697,737	1,183,732
Capital Resources	443,000	543,000
Project Resources	3,972,269	5,532,400
Total	\$6,066,954	\$ 7,930,507

- FY18 new resources: \$5.64M
- FY19 new resources: \$8.41M
- FY20 new resources:\$7.39M
- FY21 new resources: \$6.07M
- FY22 New Resources: \$7.93M
